


Did you know...?



Researchers believe additional-language learners tend to be more divergent thinkers, with improved memory and attention span.

The French Immersion Program

- 83% to 100% classroom program in French for Grades 1 & 2
- Emphasis on oral communication in Grade
- English language instruction is introduced in Grade 3



How much is taught in French?

GRADE 1 & 2

83 - 100% French

Subjects are taught in French

GRADE 3 & 4

83% French

50 minutes of English Language GRADE 5 & 6

67% French

100 minutes of instruction in English

GRADE 7 & 8

50% French

150 minutes of instruction in English

What happens in High School?

- 10 courses in French
- Graduate with a Certificate of French Immersion Studies
- Interested Grade 12 students can challenge the Diplôme D'Études en Langue Française (DELF)

(Cummins, J., 1998)


How to Support Your Child




Applications are chosen using a digitally randomized lottery system.


